1. Graduate students, studying in the Department of Finance, are required to take at least 43 credit hours of required and elective courses and passed the requirements of university's qualified exams for master degree and the exams of department's fundamental and professional skills in order to graduate.
2. The elective courses on this Course Outline may be counted toward total graduation credits by students who entered the university prior to the 2014-6 academic year.
3. In accordance with MCU English Abilities for Study, the graduate students are required to pass the English exam before the graduation.
4. The credits, receiving from the other department's master programs, are granted as the Elective Courses for graduation, but it must be required to conform with the following limitations:
 - (1) The courses should be taken from the other department's master program in the School of Management or any other related to the Finance Courses in the other schools.
 - (2) When the courses are conformed with the above requirements, they also need to be approved by the Department head or the directors may be
